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## How do i replace my kindle battery

Remove this screw located to the bottom left of the battery to the logic board. You'll need to pop this clip up with your plastic pry tool. Simply stick the end of your pry tool underneath the clip and gently pull upwards until it unfastens from the logic board. To remove the battery, I do not recommend using the plastic pull tab. There is guite a bit of adhesive underneath the battery and break the adhesive that way. Once the battery is free from the adhesive, you can pull the old battery out of the phone. There are no other connectors holding it in. As a side note, there is a tiny grounding clip that sits right where you unscrewed your battery from. Do NOT lose this clip. It grounds your cellular antenna. You will need to make sure it is in place before installing the new battery. How to install a new battery in your iPhone 4 Make sure your grounding clip is in place. It should be lined up you can snap your new battery in place. Just line up the clip on the battery to where it gets seated on the logic board and snap it down. You should hear it click into place. Set the new battery in place and line it up. Replace the #00 screw that holds the battery and grounding clip in place.
