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## Teaching closed syllables

The closed and open syllables are the first two types of syllables that students should learn. Outside the six types of syllables, these two are the easiest for students to master. What is a closed syllable? In its simplest form, a closed syllable is a vowel followed by a consonant. Examples include the cap, sit and up. It is called a closed syllable because the vowel is *À ¢ à,~ À* "closed in" by a consonant. In closed syllables, the vowel usually says its low sound. More than a consonant can be used to close one syllable, like in the dish and in relaxing. And many multi-physilist words contain closed syllables, like in insect, rabbit and napkin. What is an open syllable? An open syllable has a vowel at the end of the syllable. Nothing comes after the vowel, As in no, mine, and we. She doesn't immediately recognize the word because she has never read it before. She sees that the A is followed by an consonant, which means that it is in a closed syllable, so the most likely vowel says his low sound. A closed syllable is a syllable with a short voice sound and one or more consonants at the end. See the graphics below for examples of closed syllables. What happens in a closed syllable is that the consonant (l) after the vowel is closing and not allowing him to say his name, so the vowel makes a short sound. The closed syllable includes CVC words and words that end in -ck, -THT, -DGE and the rule of the interdental wire.CVC The words of Syllablecvc closed are words that have the consonant-vocal-consonant model as a cat and mop. Usually they are the first words that children learn to read, so it's a natural progression to teach the closed syllable First-Çk SillableWords closed that have a short and fine voice sound with the / k / sound are written with -ck. Examples include luck, back and wick. I say to my students if a word ends with the / k / sound and the vowel does not say his name, then the / k / is written -ck.it words ending inside / K / Have a long vocalic sound or another consonant sound in the middle so it was written with only -k only. Examples include milk, lake, garbage.-TCH SillableWords closed that have a short vowel immediately followed by / who are written -CH. In this case, the / CH / Sound is connected to the vocal sound. Examples include patches and witch.Words are written with -CH in the end if they have a consonant after the short vowel or a long voice sound. Examples include Punch and Coach. There are some exceptions to this rule that are taught together with the rule.-DGE closed Syllifridida you know that the words in English do not end up in J? Therefore, if a word ends with *À / J /* Sound it is written - or -ge. Examples include Edge, Judge and Age.Words with a short voice sound that ends with *À / J /* Sound are written -ded.
