Estos adaptadores son difíciles de encontrar y difícil también es el comprobar si realmente funcionan. En mi caso parece que la batería hace que funcione bien el fotómetro, ya que la mayor parte de las fotos salieron bien expuestas en modo automático. Uno de los problemas que conlleva utilizar un voltaje mayor es que tienden a subexponer nuestras fotografías debido al exceso de carga. El modo automático funciona a las mil maravillas, cuando la cámara entiende que no existe luz suficiente, se niega a tomar la foto y bloquea el obturador. Una opción es poner la cámara en modo flash y utilizar el modo manual. Dependiendo de la cantidad de luz puedes llegar a sacar algo decente. El visor telemétrico es complejo de utilizar, consiste en unir la escena y hacer coincidir los reflejos. Una vez te haces a él es sencillo teniendo en cuenta los metros de enfoque que marca el objetivo, de esta manera podemos lograr buenos resultados.
